We are currently recruiting a trainer, who will deliver the COSCA Certificate in Counselling Skills at our premises in Perth and/or online over an academic year. The sessions could be held on weekday evenings, weekends or weekday daytime at your preference.

To be successful in this role you will be an experienced counsellor and trainer. You will be able to work independently or with a co-trainer, in accordance with Rowan's method for delivering the COSCA Certificate of Counselling Skills, whilst bringing your own unique approach to the delivery of the course.

Job Description

Job Title: Trainer, COSCA Certificate in Counselling Skills

Responsible to: Rachel Weiss, Head of Training

Location: online and/or face-to-face in our Perth city-centre premises

Hours: 4 modules per academic year

Dates: to be agreed between Rowan and the trainer

Pay: £80 for each Unit ie evening or half day, 3 hours. This includes all preparation, case management, and communication with students, except for interviews which are paid at £32 per student and Information Sessions and Inductions Sessions at £32 per hour.

Attendance at meetings is paid at £10 per hour.

£160 per marking day per module to cover 6 assignments, additional assignments are paid at £25 per assignment.

So if you deliver a module to 12 students, you would be paid £1504 per module ie £6012 for the whole Certificate over a year.

Status: This is a freelance, sessional post. You will be an independent contractor, not an employee or a worker, so there is no sick pay or holiday pay.

Start date: We hope that you will be able to start delivering Module 1 in August or September 2021 if delivering 3 hours per week, or in October if 6 hours per week.

Purpose of role

To deliver the COSCA Certificate in Counselling Skills to Rowan students to the standards of COSCA and Rowan.

Organisational structure

Rowan is a family-run partnership. The Senior Partner is responsible for the day-to-day running of the business and is also Head of Training, Coaching and Mediation.

There are six employees: three office managers, a finance administrator, a marketing person and the Head of Counselling. We have over 50 self-employed counsellors working for us on a sessional basis throughout the UK, 5 coaches and 3 COSCA trainer posts. We are currently looking to fill 2 of these COSCA trainer posts: one online (pending validation from COSCA) and one face-to-face in Perth.

Main duties and responsibilities for Trainer

- i) Deliver the COSCA Certificate Dates to be agreed by trainer and Senior Partner.
- ii) Deliver using the Rowan materials and in the Rowan way, but being free to adapt and be creative within these guidelines.
- iii) Attend case management and Rowan trainers' meetings.
Case management is once per module. Trainers' meetings are twice a year.
- iv) Give supportive yet challenging feedback to students on practical and written work
- v) Assess students' written and practical work against learning outcomes of the course. Assignments are usually submitted by the 10th Unit of each module and are marked in the fortnight between the 10th and 12th Units, at a time of your choosing, so that students receive your feedback before giving their presentation in Unit 12.
- vi) Arrange your own training supervision, in accordance with COSCA regulations, with a supervisor whose suitability is agreed with Rowan.

You will have a group of 6-11 students. If we have more than 11 students we use two trainers. As part of your induction, you will usually co-train with an existing Rowan trainer for the first cohort, regardless of the number of students. After induction, you will deliver solo, except when there are more than 11 students.
